

Directory Tree Menu

This extension implements a responsive menu that displays a list of links in a tree-like format inspired by the look of the Windows file tree. Levels can be expanded/collapsed by the user and the customizable icons.



Note: The place holder in the workspace only renders a preview of the categories of the first level and item expanded. You will need to publish or preview the page to see the menu in action.

General Properties

You will use the General page of the properties to add, edit and remove menu items.

Select **Add** to insert a new item to the menu. You can set the following properties:

- **Text**
Specifies the text of the folder or link.
- **Link to**
Specifies the type of link: Website, Internal Page or None.
Use **Website** to link to a page in an external website.
Use **Internal Page** to link to a page within the current website.
Use **None** to create a folder that will be the parent for other links. This item will get a '+'/'-' icon in front of it.
- **URL**
Specifies the URL (Internet Address) of the item.
- **Target**
Enter the window to which the link is targeted. For example: _blank (opens the link in a new window).

Select **Edit** to modify the properties of an existing item.

To remove an item from the menu click **Delete**.

Move Up

Move the selected item up amongst its siblings.

Move Down

Move the selected item down amongst its siblings.

Move Left

Make the selected item a sibling of its parent.

Move Right

Make the selected item the child of its preceding sibling.

To rearrange the items in the menu you can also use drag and drop to move the items around.

Style Properties

Set style properties, like font family, size, colors etc.

Overflow

This overflow can be used to control the overflow behavior of the menu.

- **Default**
The content of the menu is fully visible. No clipping will occur.
- **Hidden**
The content is clipped, but the browser does not display a scroll-bar to see the rest of the content.
- **Scroll**
The content is clipped, but the browser displays a scroll-bar to see the rest of the content.
- **Auto**
If the content is clipped, the browser will display a scroll-bar to see the rest of the content.

Line height

Specifies the line-height of the text. This creates extra spacing at the top and bottom of the text.

Sub level indent

Specifies the indent for sub levels.

Text indent

Specifies the spacing between the icon and the text

Padding

Specifies the horizontal padding.

Responsive Properties

The font-size, padding, spacing, icon size and line-height are responsive, which means that they can have a different value in breakpoints.

How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install this extension.

Alternatively, you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually this folder is in this location:

My Documents\WYSIWYG Web Builder\system\extensions\

WYSIWYG Web Builder 16 or higher to support responsive font-size
