

Dropzone

Dropzone helps you add file drag and drop functionality to your web site. It supports image thumbnail previews, progress bars, multiple files and synchronous uploads. The extension also includes a PHP script to handle the server sided part of the upload.

General

In this section, you can customize the style of the drop zone, like fonts, text and background color etc.

Upload Button

Specifies the style and position of the upload button.
Select 'no button' to upload the dropped files instantly.

Note that 'remove file' will only remove the file from the queue. No files will be removed from the server!

Icon

Specifies the icon that is displayed in the drop zone.

Text

In this section, you can customize the various text items.

Upload Options

Allowed file types

Specifies the file types accepted by the PHP upload script. File extensions must be separated by a comma: jpg,jpeg,gif,png

Upload folder

Specifies the folder where file will be uploaded to. The folder must already exist on the server and it needs to be write enabled. The name should not include a trailing backslash. Note: ***if this extension does not work for you, the problem is most likely related to the upload folder configuration!***

Maximum file size

Specifies the maximum file size (in MB) that is accepted by the PHP upload script. Note that most hosting services limit the upload size to between 2 and 4 Mb. While you can set the upload limit for this script, it will nevertheless comply with the limits imposed by the hosting providers. Only your web host can change this!

Parallel Uploads

How many file uploads to process in parallel. This value may depend on the server configuration.

Uploads multiple files

Whether to send multiple files in one request.

Script name

Specifies the name of the PHP script. When you use multiple file uploader extension on your website you will need to make sure this file name is unique otherwise they will overwrite each other's settings!

How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install this extension.

Alternatively, you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually this folder is in this location:

My Documents\WYSIWYG Web Builder\system\extensions\

Requirements:

- This extension requires a PHP enabled web account.
- A modern browser with HTML5 support
- To use this extension, you need to create a (writable) folder on the server where the files will be uploaded to.
- WYSIWYG Web Builder 11.2 or higher
